Journal Background

Scope and Call for Papers

Performance information is a key contributor to process improvements and the development of the industry by providing quantitative and qualitative impetus. Examples of performance information include: cost and schedule deviations, satisfaction ratings, metrics to quantify risk, environmental factors, and measures of change at the organizational level. The industry can be defined as the built environment, the delivery of services, goods, and information technology.

The value in performance information can be seen in the application of the information to: identify a challenge, improve or refine a process, and initiate change. The value can be perceived at numerous levels and entities within an organization or across a project.



Objectives

The journal seeks to be a source for documented performance information and to serve as a guidepost for lessons learned, best practices, and the proliferation of performance based value models in the international built environment. The JAPIV seeks to engage researchers and practitioners alike in the exploration, development, and improvement of performance information and value based models through its publication and peer-review process.

Content

The journal accepts for review all original papers related to the scope and objectives of this journal. The principal areas covered include: approaches to the delivery of projects, best practices, change management, efficiency, performance metrics, procurement, organizational management, risk management, supply chain, value-based.

The journal is open access, with all current and previous issues appearing online. We welcome anyone to register online to submit or be a reviewer for our journal who supports and works towards our goals.

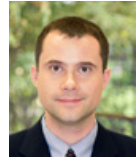
